

Leadership Innovation Lab: Ethics & Critical Thinking

Summary

Leadership Innovation Lab is the third elective in the Leadership and International Relations Program. The purpose of this course is to complete the leadership preparation cycle and ready students to plan and execute their Capstone Project and internship senior year. In this course students will: a) develop their own questioning skills and ability to make evidenced-based decisions, b) examine their values and ethics, through a variety of case studies in the areas of science, technology, and society, and c) find solutions to real world problems in their local school, community, and beyond.

Leadership Innovation Lab: The Big Questions

The Leadership Innovation Lab is driven by four big questions:

- **Big Question 1:** How does one develop one's sense of ethics and values?
- **Big Question 2:** How does one learn to ask the right questions and make the best decisions?
- **Big Question 3:** How can the individual make an impact on their world?
- **Big Question 4:** How does one turn an idea into action?
